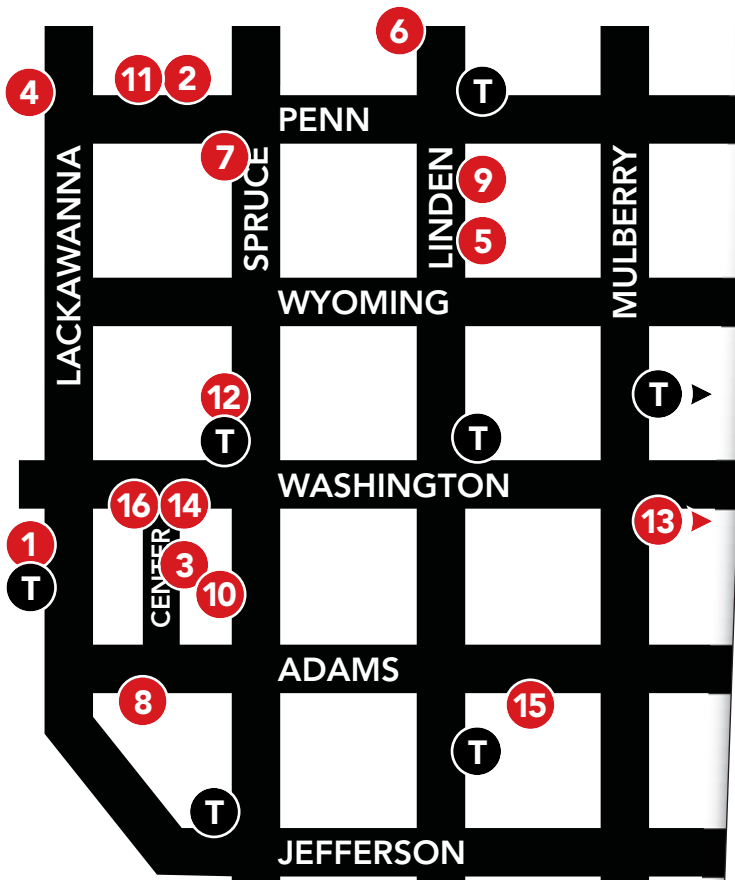


# Fruit of the Vine
